<p>Assist your child to find objects in your home that start with each letter of the alphabet:</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>A Apple</p> <p>B Box</p> <p>C Car</p>	<p>Have your child practice hopping across the room on 2 feet.</p> <p>Have your child count the number of hops it takes to get across the room.</p> <p>Practice hopping on 1 foot and then on the other foot.</p>	<p>Help your child fill a small container with water and place it in the freezer to see how long it will take to freeze and turn into ice.</p> <p>Later, talk about why it froze.</p>	<p>Take your container out of the freezer with your child and have them set it on a surface where they can observe it to see how long it takes to melt.</p> <p>Talk about why it melted.</p>	<p>Have your child draw a picture of themselves and write down the body parts for them on their drawing as they tell you such as head, arms, legs.</p> <p>Have your child write his or her name on the picture when done.</p>
