List the struggles he/she faced and how they dealt with them. | Write a letter to one of your friends. See if you can get the address and mail it to them. | Make a scavenger hunt for your family with things in your yard. As you collect the items make a map of your yard marking where you find items and then sit down with your family and discuss whether they are found in nature or man made. |
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
