

Survey Results from CGD

The content below is to provide a representative sampling of the information gathered from the 86 responses we received to our “How are we doing with COVID-19” parent survey.

Question one asked parents to check the box that best describes how you feel the school is doing with COVID-19 mitigation.

CGD Comment: We are pleased to see that a combined 86% of respondents feel that mitigation has been handled either mostly or very well. Of course that leaves 14% who feel we fell short. We take this information seriously and are always looking for ways to improve.

Question two asked parents for both positive and negative comments about how their own students are handling the COVID control measures. Here is a mixed sampling of those comments:

“They seem to be doing fine. No complaints.” “I like that they have the choice to wear either a shield or a mask.” “My concern would be at lunch time. My son stated that they are not spread apart.” “My student is fine, I wish all would wear masks at football games, including administration.” “He is handling it very well and is glad to be in school.” “Very well now that the quarantine rule has been lifted, thank you for that!” “I feel like the toxicity of these sanitizers is far worse than the virus itself.” “He is doing great.” “She is doing what is required.” “Doing ok. Wish they didn’t have to wear a mask or shield so they can have their freedom and breath.”

CGD Comment: These comments are very helpful for us to determine the kinds of concerns and considerations that families are dealing with. We discover that something that concerns one family may be a positive for another. All concerns are taken seriously and this feedback will help guide us as we continue.

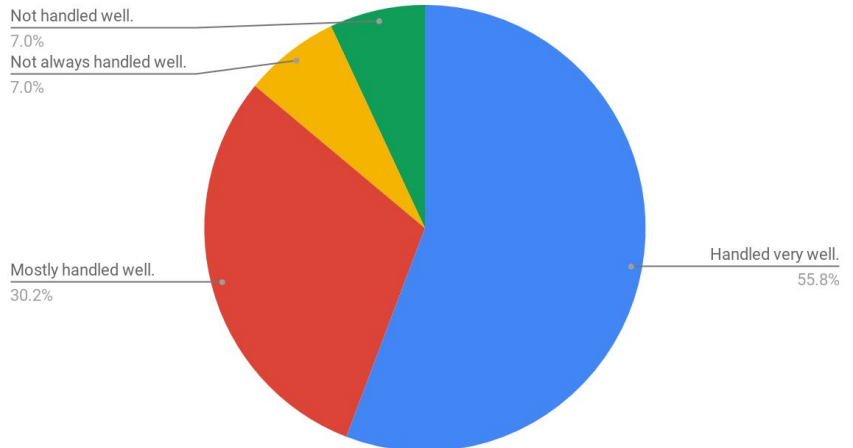
Question three asked parents for suggestions as to how we might better support their children right now. Here is a mixed sampling of those comments:

“Be patient.” “Nothing. Keep up the good work and we are praying for all the teachers through this.” “If there are kids choosing/needing to wear face shields, please sit those students by each other, that way it protects those wearing masks from having to quarantine based on policy updates.” “Keep up the good work! We appreciate you!” “CGD STAFF YOU ARE NOT ALONE! WE SUPPORT YOU GUYS 100%!” “Be prompt about reporting known exposures to protect all.” “The survival rate for ages 20 and under is 99.9997 percent. This is not a real danger to children.” “I think things are being handled very well.” “No suggestions.” “There’s no exception for social distancing and wearing masks. If you say masks are required at the school, they should be required.”

CGD Comment: Many of the messages were related to the wearing of masks. Some are in favor of more restrictive mask policy while others feel that masks are not needed at all. There were also a large number of supportive comments. Additionally many expressed no suggestions at all.
