Clarion-Goldfield-Dows Community School District is excited to announce that the USDA has extended
FREE MEALS TO ALL ENROLLED CHILDREN (18 YEARS & YOUNGER) THROUGH THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR

Who can get free meals?

All enrolled students attending in-person or on-line classes will receive FREE meals.

When does this start?

October 1, 2020, through May 24, 2021, or until USDA funds are no longer available.

Where are the free meals available?

FREE MEALS will be served to all children (18 years & younger) at our Elementary, Middle School & High School.

Elementary – Breakfast 7:45 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. Lunch 10:50 a.m. to 11:55 a.m.

Middle School – Breakfast 7:50 a.m. to 8:20 a.m. Lunch 12:17 p.m. to 12:45 p.m.

High School – Breakfast 7:15 a.m. to 8:20 a.m. Lunch 11:19 a.m. to 12:25 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Lunch Accounts will be charged if your child takes second servings or any A la Carte items.

What is being served?

All children (18 years & younger) will receive FREE breakfast and FREE lunch during regular operating school days. Please see CGD school website for meal menus at clargold.org and click on our Lunch Menu.

Why do things keep changing?

Our program has to follow certain rules set at the national level by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). We have made changes based on what is allowed by the USDA.
