Clarion Goldfield Dows District Technology, Internet, and Device Acceptable Use Policy by building:

High School and Middle School

I fully understand that the technology device MacBook Air (MBA) or iPad and related equipment I am being issued is the property of the Clarion-Goldfield-Dows Community School District (District). I agree to all of the terms and conditions in the device Handbook, including the responsibility for the safe return of equipment issued to me. I agree to all the terms and conditions in the Clarion-Goldfield-Dows School policy handbook on appropriate use of computers, computer network systems and the internet. I understand that the District has the right, but not the duty, to monitor my use of the technology device and related equipment, including, but not limited to, the right to monitoring sites that I might visit on the internet, and the right to examine and copy computer files that I maintain, and the right to review and copy any email or messages that I send or receive. I will return the (MBA) or iPad technology device and any related equipment I am issued in the same condition in which I receive it.

I understand that I am financially responsible for any physical damage or loss due to negligence of any component of the technology device and/or related equipment I am issued. In case of an incident, I agree to report the details and turn in the equipment for evaluation and repair. I will not attempt repairs on my own or try to replace equipment without expressed approval by the District.

Elementary

On behalf of my child, I agree to all the terms and conditions in the Clarion-Goldfield-Dows Elementary School policy handbook on appropriate use of computers, computer network systems and the internet. I understand that the District has the right to monitor my child's use of the technology and related equipment, including, but not limited to, the right to monitor sites that my child might visit on the internet, and the right to examine and copy computer files that they might maintain, and the right to review and copy any communication that they send or receive. It is further understood that elementary students are not allowed to make email or internet contact with an individual outside the district unless that contact is designated and monitored by a teacher or administrator. I understand that the school makes every effort to filter internet content and monitor internet activity, in keeping with CIPA standards and to protect the student. I agree to report any sign of possible negative internet activity to the classroom teacher immediately. It is my intention to be a partner with the school in helping my child reap the benefits of the use of technology while protecting them from the potential dangers.

Liability, Repair and/or Replacement Costs

In case of device damage or loss of any kind, students and parent(s)/guardians are liable as follows:

- \$50 for a first incident of insured loss. Up to \$50 fee for lost adapters. - Up to \$100 for additional insured loss.
- Up to \$250 for uninsured losses without negligence. - Up to \$500 for uninsured losses that could be prevented.

Damaged or Stolen MBA - In the event that your MBA suffers physical damage or is lost or stolen, students (and ultimately parents or guardians) are responsible for anything not covered under warranty.

Examples of Covered Situations -

(Subject to the deductible, but not limited to)

- a) Dropped devices with cracked screens
- b) Lightning strikes
- c) A device with extensive case damage or broken parts
- d) Stolen device

Examples of Non-Covered Situations - (but not limited to)

- a) Damage due to willful acts or gross negligence
- b) Exposure to extreme heat or cold
- c) Water damage due to sewer back-up
- d) Non-lightning electrical events
- e) An MBA that is simply missing or lost
- f) An MBA stolen from unattended vehicles
- g) Non-accidental behavior
